Bills Opposed

AB 1087 (Irwin): School attendance: interdistrict transfers

- **This bill would extend the District of Choice Program, with multiple changes**
 - **Communications**
 - **First priority – Siblings**
 - **Second priority - English learners, eligible for free or reduced-price meals, or foster youth.**
 - **Notification Requirements**
 - **Free transportation after July 1, 2020 for some students (up to 10 miles)**
 - **This bill was referred to the Committee on Education on March 6**



Bills Supported

AB 346 (Daly): Redevelopment: housing successor: Low and Moderate Income Housing

- **Allow the housing successor to use funds in the Low and Moderate Income Housing Asset Fund for homelessness services, transitional housing, or emergency housing services, as well as for the development of affordable housing**
- **This bill was referred to the Committees on Housing and Community Development along with Local Government**



Bills Supported

AB 396 (Chen): Pupil attendance; interdistrict transfers

- **This bill would extend the current DOC program until 2022**
- **Identical to SB 52 (Newman)**
 - **This bill was referred to the Committee on Education**

SB 52 (Newman): Pupil attendance; interdistrict transfers

- **This bill would extend the current DOC program until 2022**
- **Identical to AB 396 (Chen)**
 - **This bill passed the Committee on Education (Ayes 6, Noes, 0) and was referred to the Appropriation Committee where it was placed on the suspense file**
