TO ALL RFP HOLDERS AND PROJECT WALK ATTENDEES:

The following offers answers to Addendum No. 2. The information below will be incorporated into the RFP per this Addendum.

1. We know that pathways exist between the City yard, City Hall and Community services but are they useable?

No, the bandwidth capacity between the buildings is at its maximum threshold. New cabling will be necessary.

2. Does the City have a useable pathway to Walker well? Do you have conduit in the street that can be accessed for fiber connectivity?

There is not an existing usable pathway at this time. Walker Well is not connected to City Hall and no existing conduit is linking the two facilities.

3. In Clarifications #6, the City is asking for specific locations of electrical boxes required in order to facilitate the surveillance system at their facilities. We can estimate the need for such boxes based on the walk we did but being specific in the initial proposal may be a stretch. What is the point of this requirement?

Staff understands the location and number of electrical boxes may change after award of contract. The proposals should include an estimate of electrical boxes.

4. Regarding climate control or any potential redesign of an IT space, this was not assessed or discussed during the initial job walk. Now with the need to build a new network and install a new fiber backbone additional hardware will be required and the prospect of an IT room redesign is likely. We respectfully request additional time and the means to be able to better assess this (another site visit or detailed photos).

At this time, the City doesn't have the resources necessary to conduct extra project walks or infrastructure research. Staff understands this project requires more pre-construction costs and research, which should be factored into the contractor's proposal. Contingency cost will be considered as part of the proposal.

5. Clarification #5 states: The City will NOT be considering proposals which include products made by Dahua or Hikvision. Was there a reason as to why?

The City is lifting this product restriction and will consider products made by Dahua or Hikvision.

6. Walker Well network back haul to PD: Can wireless receivers/transmitters be mounted on top of Centre Point building?

An agreement with the current business owner(s) of CenterPoint would be necessary. The City will not be negotiating this contract.

7. Who will provide 110VAC power on roof?

This should be apart of the contractor's design plan. The City will not install infrastructure for the requested surveillance system solution.

8. Can this be surveyed before RFP deadline?

The City will not be accepting any more project walks at this time.

9. It is clear in the RFI that the City infrastructure will not support CCTV camera recording. Can client viewing software reside on the client network?

Yes, the software CAN reside on network.
